POSITION SUMMARY: This position is responsible for assisting in the general shipping and receiving operations of the Container Shipping department.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Operate a forklift to transport parts.
- 2. Load and unload parts and/or containers from trucks.
- 3. Apply lids and stickers on large and small containers.
- 4. Accurately count, stack, and band/wrap parts for shipping.
- 5. Take photographs of loads.
- 6. Sign for receivables and turn in invoices to the Container Shipping Lead.
- 7. Work as a road sign handler directing traffic.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Ability to operate a forklift.
- 2. Ability to take over on a temporary basis when Lead is unavailable.
- 3. Have a good knowledge of how loads are organized and stacked.
- 4. Good communication skills.
- 5. Ability to speak and comprehend English.
- 6. Ability to read and identify sequences of numbers.
- 7. Quick in comprehending training as provided by the Container Shipping Lead.
- 8. Ability to adjust to a highly flexible and demanding work environment.
- 9. Basic computer proficiency.
- 10. Safety conscious behavior.
- 11. Excellent attendance.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Lift, carry, push and or pull 1 - 40 lbs frequently.

- 2. Squat/kneel, bend/stoop, twist/turn, grasp and reach overhead and outward frequently.
- 3. Sit, stand and walk for 1 10 hours per day.
- 4. Ability to work in a 35 85 degree Fahrenheit work environment.
