JOB TITLE: Maintenance Technician - Journey level

CLASSIFICATION: Non-exempt

DEPARTMENT: Maintenance

REPORTS TO: Plant Manager

POSITION SUMMARY: This position is responsible performing technical tasks and general building maintenance on the company's facilities and equipment as part of the Maintenance Team. This is a hands-on mechanical technical position.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Perform technical work tasks as assigned to: complete maintenance projects, resolve emergency breakdowns and conduct equipment preventive maintenance and procure local repair parts.
- 2. Troubleshoot and execute mechanical repair of: forklifts, plant manufacturing equipment and minor building maintenance issues, with guidance from Team Lead-man and Plant Management.
- 3. Ensure that all assigned maintenance activities are performed safely and effectively in accordance with Plant procedures.
- 4. Work with area lead to plan, source and procure replacement parts in support of maintenance objectives.
- 5. Accurately record time worked and parts expenditure on equipment servicing or repair on online computer network system.
- 6. Assist equipment manufacturer factory level support personnel or contracted technicians on plant equipment service and/or repair.
- 7. Participate in the technical training of production personnel to perform assigned preventative maintenance and routine equipment cleaning in a safe manner.
- 8. Maintain and repair plant pneumatic hand power tools.
- 9. Perform preventive maintenance tasks general facilities equipment and plant production work center machines.

OUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Minimum 3 years experience in maintenance of manufacturing equipment, preferably in a steel fabrication or heavy manufacturing environment.
- 2. Must have excellent mechanical and fair electrical troubleshooting background.
- 3. Experience in troubleshooting and repairing: mechanical, pneumatic and hydraulic systems.
- 4. Must be familiar with basic building electrical and facility maintenance.
- 5. Ability to read and interpret machine manuals, equipment blueprints and some familiarity with electrical schematics.

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- 6. Strong orientation toward safety, quality and task completion in a dynamic manufacturing environment.
- 7. Ability to work well under pressure and use initiative to meet team expectations.
- 8. Willingness to work flexible schedule hours to maintain Plant operations.
- 9. Good verbal and written communication skills.
- 10. Strong problem solving skills and demonstrated ability to effectively respond to change.
- 11. Understanding and support of Company policies and procedures.
- 12. Computer proficiency for record keeping and communication is highly desired.
- 13. Ability to operate a forklift and 40 ft. (vertical reach) aerial man lift (training provided).
- 14. Safety conscious behavior.
- 15. Excellent attendance record.

SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE DESIRED:

- 1. Working knowledge and understanding of industrial lasers, hydraulic press brakes, hydraulic & mechanical shears and welding equipment.
- 2. Operational experience working with CNC manufacturing equipment.
- 3. Experience in moving, set up, tear down and calibration manufacturing equipment.
- 4. Practical knowledge of industrial painting systems.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Lift, carry, push and or pull 1 40 lbs occasionally.
- 2. Squat/kneel, bend/stoop, twist/turn, grasp and reach overhead and outward occasionally.
- 3. Sit, stand and walk for 1 8 hours per day.
- 4. Ability to work in a 55 85 degree Fahrenheit work environment.
- 5. Work in an industrial environment wearing hearing protection, vision protection and steel-toed shoes.
- 6. Visual acuity; able to read precision measuring instruments.

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
